


Before charging



Check the battery

Check the battery for visible damage.



Check the truck and cables

Check the cables and plugs in the truck for damage.



Check the charger


Check the cables and plugs on the charger for damage.

Starting the charging process




Plug in the charger plug

Plug the charger plug into the socket provided on the battery.



Press 'START'


Check that the charging process has started correctly in the display.



Charge the battery


Check that the battery is charging properly and check the charge status in the display.

Stopping the charging process




Press 'STOP'

Remove charger plug


Remove the charger plug once the charging process has ended.



Stow away the charger plug


Stow away the charger plug neatly on the charger.

Further instructions




Interim charging possible at all times

Use periods of inactivity or breaks for interim charging. You can charge li-ion batteries at any time for as long as you like.



Fully charge once a week

We recommend that you fully charge the battery once a week.



Avoid fully discharging

Fully charge the battery (100%) at least every 3 months.
